1. Approve & Sign Easements for 64 Webster St. – Possible Vote(s) (00:32):

In the agenda packet is a memo from Rich Bowe/Town Counsel, dated May 25, 2021, re: Webster Street Easements and Motion "I move that the Board vote to retain the easement interests in land as set out in the 64 Webster Street "Memorandum of Sale" and to authorize the Town Administrator to execute any pertinent documents on the Town's behalf".
