(6:34PM) (0:30) Matt Benoit updated the committee on the questions and changes to article 14 on solar and the only amendment accepted at this time is the item 6.8.21 to put a period at the end of Douglas Zoning bylaws and strike the remaining verbiage. The Town Moderator feels that there wasn't sufficient time given to the residents to be able to make the other two changes. Carol Gogolinski feels that they should wait on the whole bylaw then until all three matters can be voted on. Mr. Benoit feels that it is important to have a solar bylaw right now and not put it off any longer. Less Stevens planning board member spoke on the bylaw and what the board voted. Mike Hutnak also feels that he doesn't want to put the bylaw forward without the other amendments.
