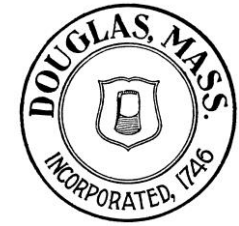

Eligibility Requirements

- 60 years old or over
- Own or occupy the property for which real estate taxes are paid and abatement sought

Job Opportunities

There is a variety of jobs available. Some include:

Municipal & School Departments
Work in classrooms, offices, libraries and on special projects.

Level of Town appropriation will determine the number of participants

Selection Process

- Applicant must meet eligibility requirements
- Applicant must have appropriate skills for position
- Applicant and department head must agree that the position is a good match



Benefit Limits

- Hourly rate shall not exceed the state minimum wage
- Maximum allowed hours is 125

Participants are exempt from State taxes, but are **NOT** exempt from Federal or Medicare taxes.
