2. (3:55 TS) 6:30 PM (RDA) Public Meeting: Request for Determination of Applicability, 1 B Street, Map 142 Lot 132 (Barn Demo) – Possible votes  
(4:15 TS) Motion to waive the reading of the public notice made by Jim Foran, 2<sup>nd</sup> by Mike Greco. Roll call vote – Jim Foran, Brendan Doyle, Mike Greco, Josiah Burch, Mark Mungeam all in favor.  
Matt Benoit read into the record the letter from the applicant's representative that he received today, which is now on record, the applicants representative stated their apologies for not being able to attend the meeting explained the need for the barn removal. Matt Benoit showed photos of the site (pre-and-post removal) and that the barn has already been removed, so this is an after the fact filing because the building department declared it a public safety issue. Mark Mungeam declared the hearing closed.

3. (13:45 TS) 6:30 PM (OOC Amendment – DEP #143-1042) Public Hearing: Order of Conditions Amendment: The Cubes at Gilboa, Gilboa Street, (Storm/water & Infrastructure Correction), Map 139 & 140 Lot 1 & 9 – Possible votes

Rob Cherrier, Richard Cherrier's son for Lackey Dam Properties seeking a certificate of compliance. Matt Benoit did a site walk in December and showed photos of the site and recommended issuing a partial certificate of compliance until the grass has grown.
